## HHS School Counseling Program

The Hartford High School Counseling Office provides counseling programs in three domains: academic, career, and personal/social. Our services and programs help students resolve emotional, social, or behavioral problems and help them develop a clear focus or sense of direction. The HHS counseling program includes a number of offerings to support students throughout their high school experiences as follows:

- A dedicated 9th grade counselor spends the entire year supporting 9th graders as they seek to successfully navigate their new environment.
- All counselors work with 9th graders to develop and maintain a **Personalized Learning Plan** (PLP) that outlines each student's strengths, areas for growth and long-term college and career goals.
- \*10th–12th grade counselors conduct **annual meetings** with each student and family to provide academic and career guidance related to the student's PLP.
- \*We make timely referrals and engage in **problem solving** with students to support their individual academic success.
